# Summer Choral Academy

(All-state Clinic for High School Students)

*August 5-6, 2009*

*on the Iowa State University campus*

Iowa State University will host the seventh annual Summer Choral Academy August 5-6. The Academy's main mission is to help prepare high school singers for their **All-State auditions** in a choral setting. It would be advantageous for schools to send balanced quartets, but all interested singers will be accepted. A team of qualified clinicians, under the leadership of Dr. James Rodde, will guide the participants in learning pitch, rhythm, and text in each piece, and offer guidance with interpretation and intonation. A healthful approach to singing will also be a primary consideration.

As a choir, the participants will record each piece at the conclusion of the two-day event, with the resulting CD made available to each. The CD will also include a midi track of each All-State piece, highlighting one's voice part.

Singers must purchase and bring their own All-State music packet with them. Packets may be purchased, beginning July 27, through Kephart's Music Center, 126 East Water St. P.O. Box 139, Decorah, IA 52101 (email: sales@kepharts.com) (Phone: 800-369-9633).

Twenty-minute voice lessons will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Space will be limited.
